Mobile Phones May we please remind you, that as part of our Safeguarding Policy, all mobile phones need to be switched off in school, and if you are doing anything more than a fleeting visit i.e. collecting your child from the Sunshine Club, they need to be handed in to the front office for safe keeping.

Gates: Could you please make sure that the gate is shut and the locking bar is closed over on entering or leaving the school. This is to safeguard all of our children.

Polite reminder: If your child is booked into the Sunshine Club after school, but no longer needs to attend the club on that evening, could you please inform either the front office or call the sunshine club on 302603 or 07582402841. This is so that we are aware of where your child is and do not therefore need to call or look for your child when they do not attend. Thank you

Warmer weather: As we will hopefully be spending more time outside next term, could you please ensure that your child has a sun hat with them to wear and to also ensure that they have applied sun cream before the start of the school day. We are happy for the children to bring in their own labelled sun cream for their own personal use. Please note that the children will need to be able to apply this themselves. We are unable to supply and to apply sun cream to any of the children.

Food: we aim to provide a healthy balanced snack and refreshments for the children daily. If your child is staying in after school club later than 4pm, and you would like them to have more than the snack provided to eat, you are welcome to provide a sandwich or healthy snack such as pasta, fruit, or cereal bar.

Last day for After School Club: Please note that the last day your child can attend After School Club this term is **Monday 20th July**. The reason for this is that we use the last day of term to deep clean the Sunshine Club, restock the cupboards and check toys and games, ready for the first day back of the new term. Children can still be booked into Breakfast Club on Tuesday 21st July (last day of term). We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause, but trust this gives you advance notice.
